## 2018 FALL TRASH PICK-UP SCHEDULE

### **MONDAY – October 15<sup>th</sup>**

ALL OF EAST MAIN ST.  
N. Gorham St.  
All streets east of Virginia St. (not including Virginia St.) to Mill St. (including Mill St.)  
North Rd. – east of Virginia St.

### **MONDAY – October 22<sup>ND</sup>**

ALL OF WEST MAIN ST.  
Locust St. and all dead end streets south of W. Main St.  
All of Virginia St. (North)  
All streets west of Virginia St.  
North Rd. – west of Virginia St.

### **MONDAY – October 29<sup>th</sup>**

All streets east of Mill St. to Thurber Drive, including E. William from Mill to Thurber and Chapel St. All of Wycliffe Rd.  
All streets south of Main St. including E & W Water St.  
(SOUTH OF THE VILLAGE)

All trash must be at the curb by MONDAY MORNING for your area. Please do not pile any trash against a Fire Hydrant, Tree or Telephone Pole. Please keep all Appliances, and Hot Water Tanks separate as they will be picked up at a different time. No refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners will be picked up unless the compressor is removed because of the freon. 55 GAL drums, tires, batteries or hazardous materials (paint, solvents or fuels) will not be picked up. There can be no more than One Truckload per household. If required the Second Truckload will be billed to you at \$100.00 per load. This service is for **Village Residents Only**. Any one observed bringing trash from outside the Village will be prosecuted.

Disposal of couches, chairs, mattresses or box springs is limited to fall pick up only.

**NOTICE: LEAVES, LIMBS and BRUSH** for the FALL PICK UP ONLY must be at the curb on the Monday of your week and will be picked up as soon as possible for that week. **Please keep them separate** from your other trash. Leaves should be in Plastic Bags; no loose leaves will be picked up. All limbs placed at the street should have the large (cut) end facing the same direction and parallel to the street.  
**THIS WILL BE THE FINAL TIME THAT LIMBS AND BRUSH WILL BE PICKED UP UNTIL SPRING. However, we will continue to compost leaves.**

NO AUTO PARTS, TIRES, PROPANE TANKS, COMPUTERS, CELL PHONES, BATTERIES or HAZARDOUS MATERIALS will be picked up. Seneca County will be holding their Annual Household Hazardous Waste Drop Off Day in the Fall. Please call (315) 539-1945 to register.

A reminder to LANDLORD'S, it is your responsibility to remove large amounts of trash from your property when tenants move in and out.

ANY ITEMS RESERVED FOR FALL PICK UP WHICH ARE PLACED OUT DURING REGULAR WEEKLY TRASH IS A VIOLATION TO SECTION 200 AND WILL BE SUBJECT TO A FEE OF \$250 (fee subject to change).

FOR ALL THOSE HAVING THE REGULAR THURSDAY TRASH PICK- UP, THANKSGIVING DAY PICK-UP WILL BE HELD ON WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 21<sup>ST</sup>, 2018.

For all other holidays, when your regular scheduled pick-up falls on that holiday, pick-up will be one day late that week. Otherwise, always put your trash out on your regular trash day.

TRASH TOTERS are available for purchase at the Office. Large-96 gals-\$90, Med-64 gals-\$65. These toters have a 10 year warranty.

RECYCLING: For information, or to order a blue box, please call the Seneca County Real Property Tax Office at (315) 539-1720.

The Village has a SIDEWALK REPLACEMENT PROGRAM available. We will pay 50% of the cost, up to \$1,000.00. Info is available at the Office.

METERS FREEZING: It is important to remember with the winter months coming to close all basement windows and to secure any major drafts that would cause your water meter to freeze. If this happens, the meter will be replaced at a cost to the homeowner of \$275.00.

UNPAID WATER BILLS will be levied to Village Taxes in June (for Village residents) and to Town and County Taxes in January (for out of Village residents).

WATER TEST SAMPLES may be brought to the village office Mondays thru Weds ONLY. The fee is \$50.00 per bottle. Sample bottles are available at the Village Office.

THE OAK ISLAND PAVILLIONS may be reserved for your picnics, weddings, birthday parties, etc. for a fee. Restroom facilities and electric services are available for use. You may contact the Village Office for more information (315) 539-9131

A permit is needed for any garage sale in the Village and may be obtained at our Office. Two 3-day sales are allowed per year. No garage sales are to be held from May 23<sup>rd</sup> to June 4<sup>th</sup> because of Memorial Day

The Community Center is open 6 days a week and offers a variety of recreational activities for people of all ages. **WINTER PARKING RULES:** will be in effect from Nov. 1<sup>st</sup> to April 1<sup>st</sup>. **NO PARKING** is allowed on any Village street from 2:00AM until 6:00AM.

The Village Board meeting is held on the second Monday of each month at 7:00PM at the Village Office. If you would like to address the Board, please call to be placed on the agenda.

The Village Tax Year runs from June 1<sup>st</sup> to May 31<sup>st</sup>. On December 1<sup>st</sup> all unpaid Village taxes will be referred to Seneca County for levy on the Town and County Tax bill issued January 1<sup>st</sup>.

The Village of Waterloo and the Town of Fayette assessment information is provided by the Town of Waterloo Assessor, Jim Cleere, at 66 Virginia Street, (315) 539-0206. You may contact him for information regarding Senior Citizen Exemptions and the STAR program. Veteran's exemptions are handled by the Seneca County Veteran's Office at (315) 539-1798.

No building or structure shall be erected, added to, demolished or structurally altered until a Zoning Permit has been issued.
